#### **About the Workshop:**

This event will include a presentation by executive members of the OB Division. Hands-on paper development discussions will follow the presentation.

### **Presentation topics include:**

- Reasons why papers are rejected at top journals
- ➤ How to identify novel research questions from real-life phenomena
- Integrating theory into study design
- > Improving your chances of getting a revise and resubmit
- > Dealing with revise and resubmits
- > Importance of building strong international research partnerships

#### Roundtable paper development sessions:

- > Feedback on papers that authors are considering for submission to top journals.
- Discussions will focus on framing, methodological rigor, data analysis and interpretation.

As space is limited, preference will be given first to those whose papers are being discussed in the roundtables. Additional spots will be allocated on the basis of first come, first served.

- ➤ Those who wish to have their paper reviewed and discussed should submit an extended abstract (between 5 and 10 pages of text) of their papers or paper ideas by \*May 10, 2019\* to Alex Newman (Chair of the Global Committee of the OB Division) at a.newman@deakin.edu.au. Abstracts will be accepted on a competitive basis.
- We encourage authors to submit their extended abstract as soon as possible. While the deadline for the OB paper development workshop is May 10, authors of submissions received by April 10 will receive notification of a decision before April 15, the last day for early-bird registration. After this date abstracts will only be accepted if space permits.
- The abstract should provide a synopsis of the research question, its relevance and significance, a statement relating to the limited ability of extant concepts and/or theory to provide a coherent response to that question, the empirical approach, and the implications of the findings.
- Extended abstracts should be about 10 pages, double spaced, excluding tables, figures and references.

**Transportation:** The nearest airport is Denpasar (DPS). Officially, it is the I Gusti Ngurah Rai International Airport (in Bahasa Indonesia: *Bandar Udara Internasional Ngurah Rai*). It is the main airport in Bali, and the second busiest in Indonesia (behind the Jakarta airport). DPS has direct air links throughout Indonesia and Southeast Asia. It also has excellent air links to major cities throughout the Pacific Rim and Australasia. DPS is only 5-10 minutes by car from The Patra Bali.

**Entry and Visa Requirements:** Please note that you are responsible for making sure if you can travel to Bali without a visa. Otherwise, you will need to apply for a visa.
